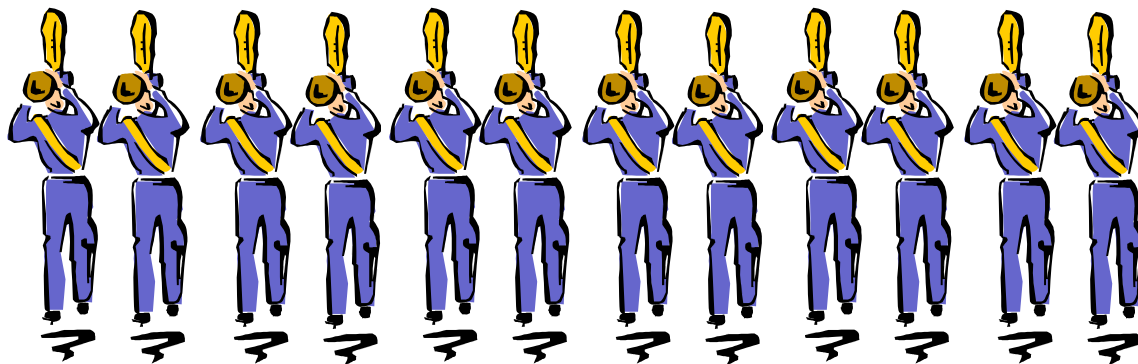

GUIDELINES

- Waitsburg Commercial Club reserves the right to accept or reject and parade entry/applicant.
- Parade participants must follow instructions of Parade Marshalls and parade organizers.
- No candy or other items can be thrown from floats or other parade vehicles or entries. Walking participants may hand candy to spectators but should take care to wear reflective items and walk a safe distance from moving vehicles or animals.
- Consumption of alcohol before or during the parade is forbidden to parade participants. Impaired drivers/participants will be removed from parade line up.
- Drivers of motorized vehicles must be licensed drivers 18 years or older and carry vehicle insurance.
- Adults must accompany children on floats or parade vehicles or animals. Children should be seated and secured on floats or vehicles.
- Equestrian or animal units must provide their own clean up crew. Crews can be shared between participants if sufficient manpower to clean up in a timely fashion.
