

RESOLUTION 2017-670

A Resolution authorizing Tour of Walla Walla to conduct a race through the City of Waitsburg on April 21 and 23, 2017

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Waitsburg as follows:

SECTION 1. The Council hereby finds and declares that:

The Tour of Walla Walla is authorized to conduct the special event of bicycle racing on and along Main Street, Bolles Road, 8th, East Tenth Street and Coppei Avenue in the City of Waitsburg on April 21 and 23, 2017;

After considering the Tour of Walla Walla's performance in past years and the unlikelihood of the City incurring clean-up costs as a result of the proposed special event, the Tour of Walla Walla is not required to post a performance bond; and

Pursuant to Waitsburg Municipal Code Title 6, Chapter 11, Tour of Walla Walla's authority to conduct the special event of bicycle racing on the specified streets is contingent on the organizers of the race satisfying the following conditions:

1. The race organizers will obtain and maintain general liability insurance in the amount of not less than \$1 million for personal injury and property damage sustained to any one person, and \$2 million for personal injury sustained and property damage growing out of any one incident or occurrence, and that names the City as an additional insured in the policy and provides that said insurance coverage will be primary and non-contributory with respect to the City in the event of a claim under the policy;

2. The organizers and race participants will comply with all State and local rules, regulations, ordinances and laws during the event;

3. Any pilot cars or flaggers utilized during the event must be certified under the State regulations in effect at the time of the event;

4. Organizers, as soon as possible, will confer with the City's law enforcement agency (Walla Walla County Sheriff) and comply with all requirements and restrictions imposed by that agency;

5. Participants shall comply with all traffic laws, except under such guidelines as may be authorized expressly by the City's law enforcement agency; AND

6. Race organizers will file with the City clerk a save harmless agreement in which the race organizers agree to defend, pay, and save harmless the City, its officers and employees from any and all claims that may be filed against the City, its officers or employees, where such claims arise in whole or in part out of the activities for which such permit is issued; excepting

therefrom, any claims arising solely out of the negligent acts or omissions of the City, its officers and employees.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Council.
