In consideration of being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work or participate in any way in the 2016 Waitsburg Celebration Days Karen Huwe Mohny Memorial ATV/UTV Poker Ride (Karen's Ride) ATV/UTV Events on Friday May 20 and Saturday, May 21, 2016, respectively, or being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (which includes the following course description):

Each of the undersigned, for himself, his personal representatives, heirs and next of kin;

1. Acknowledges, agrees, and represents that he has or will immediately upon entering any of the RESTRICTED AREAS which he enters and he further agrees and warrants that if at any time, he is in or about the RESTRICTED AREAS and he feels anything to be unsafe, he will immediately advise the officials of such and if necessary will leave the RESTRICTED AREAS and/or refuse to participate further in the events.
2. I HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE Walla Walla County, its officers, employees and agents, Columbia County, its officers, employees and agents, the promoters, participants, racing associations, sanctioning organizations or any subdivision thereof, track operators, track owners, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, rescue personnel, any persons in any RESTRICTED AREA, sponsors, advertisers, owners and leases of premises used to conduct the event, premises and event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, consultants, owners and others who give recommendations, directions or instructions or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding affiliates, successors and assigns all for the purposes therein referred to as "Releasees," FROM ALL LIABILITY TO THE UNDERSIGNED, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin FOR ANY AND ALL LOSS OR DAMAGE AND ANY CLAIM OR DEMANDS THEREFORE ON ACCOUNT OF INJURY TO THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OR RESULTING IN DEATH OF THE UNDERSIGNED ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE EVENT, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
3. HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releasees and each of them FROM LOSS, LIABILITY, DAMAGE, OR COST they may incur arising out of or related to the UNDERSIGNED'S INJURY OR DEATH, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
4. HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE arising out of or related to the event whether caused by the NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES or otherwise.
5. HEREBY acknowledges that THE ACTIVITIES OF THE events ARE VERY DANGEROUS and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. Each of the UNDERSIGNED, also expressly acknowledge that INJURIES RECEIVED MAY BE COMPOUNDED OR INCREASED BY NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS OR PROCEDURES OF THEIR RELEASEES.

6. HEREBY agrees that this Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement extends to all acts of negligence by the Releasees. INCLUDING NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the State of Washington in which the event is conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE OR GUARANTEE BEING MADE TO ME AND INTEND MY SIGNATURE TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW.

The RESITRICTED AREA is also defined to include the entire courses as described below:

1. Karen's Ride on Saturday, May 21, 2016:

- a. The first card stop (#1) on Karen's Ride is at east end of the Fairgrounds. Prior to the event, all riders and players (18 years and older) must sign a release of liability (waiver) with the sponsoring organization and attend a pre-event meeting. Pre-registration is required for ALL riders. This meeting allows all riders to review, read event materials and ask questions of the staff and details of the course map.
- b. The second card stop (#2) is approximately five miles on Wilson Hollow Rd. at the junction of Whiskey Hollow Rd. with Nordheim Road in Columbia County. The course is gradually inclining through cropland. Volunteer trail patrollers will be stationed to provide directional assistance for riders. Each card stop will include a first aid kit. The course proceeds south up Whiskey Creek Rd. for another two miles before crossing back into Walla Walla County. The road continues up Whiskey Creek for another nine miles to the Columbia County line and an additional quarter mile.
- c. The third card stop (#3) is at the junction of Whiskey Creek and Mt. Pleasant Rd. and enters Columbia County for another quarter mile. The event course then follows the county line for two additional miles and slips into Columbia County for a final 2.5 miles. Columbia County roads are accessed for just over 5.6 miles during this event. Road conditions will be closely monitored. The event reaches its highest point in elevation here. A wet, early spring may dictate wet road conditions, requiring extra caution for riders. Volunteers will utilize two-way radios and cell phones for rider safety.
- d. The fourth card stop (#4) is inside Columbia County: at the junction of Mt. Pleasant Rd. and Wilson Hollow Rd. (Jasper Mtn. Rd.) approximately two additional miles. Volunteer trail patrollers are stationed here and at major intersections to ensure rider safety and to remind the general driving public to limited scope of this one-day, special event. A first aid kit is available and communications are made with two-way radios and cell phones.
- e. The fifth card stop (#5) is at the southern-most point of the course. Mt. Pleasant Rd. turns into Coppei Rd, an additional four miles. The card is at the intersection of Coppei and Dent Rd. Coppei Rd. turns into North Coppei Creek Rd. The course continues down the grade for approximately 10 miles. Volunteer trail patrollers will direct riders, be staffed with a first aid kit and ensure rider safety.
- f. The sixth card stop (#6) will occur at the intersection of North Fork Coppei Creek Rd. and McCown Rd. Turn right on McCown Rd, to Wilson Hollow Rd. Turn left onto Wilson Hollow Rd. and proceed to the fairgrounds. Volunteer trail patrollers are

stationed here and at major intersections to ensure rider safety and to remind the general driving public to limited scope of this one-day, special event. A first aid kit is available and communications are made with two-way radios and cell phones.

- g. The seventh card stop (#7) is back at the fairgrounds after three additional miles on Wilson Hollow Rd. At each important intersection, volunteer trail patrollers will ensure rider safety, have first aid kits and provide direction to the fairgrounds.

2. Sunset Cruise: Friday, May 20, 2016:

- a. The course for the limited entry Sunset Cruise is the reverse direction (beginning at the Waitsburg Fairgrounds) of Karen’s Ride with one change. Participants will leave the fairgrounds on 8th street toward Wilson Hollow Road and continue (three miles) to McCown Road. Participants will head **west** (left turn) on McCown Road to North Coppei Creek Road, following Karen’s Ride course in reverse.
- b. The change occurs at the fourth card stop of Karen’s Ride (junction of Mt. Pleasant Rd. and Wilson Hollow Road (Jasper Mtn. Rd.)) participants will turn left (**north**) and continue on Wilson Hollow Road (Jasper Mtn. Rd.), returning to the Waitsburg Fairgrounds.

Karen’s Ride covers approximately 29.6 miles of Walla Walla County roads and 5.6 miles of Columbia County roads, a total just over 35 miles. The Sunset Cruise covers approximately 27 miles of Walla Walla County roads and 3 miles of Columbia County roads, a total of 30 miles.

Furthermore, as a participant in the 2016 Karen Huwe Mohney Memorial (Poker Ride) Karen’s Ride) ATV/UTV Events, I understand that in no event may I be permitted to exceed the 35 mph speed limit and I will comply with state law, including, but not limited to RCW 46.09.

Finally, Waitsburg Celebration Days (WCD) Association event planners understand they will be responsible for payment of the cost of repair of any damage to the County Roads or for any extraordinary repairs required because of this temporary, specially permitted use of County roads. In addition, the WCD Association also understands every participant may in no event exceed the 35 mph speed limit and participants must comply with state law, but not limited to RCW 46.09.

1. Both my parents and I believe I am qualified to participate in the event. I will inspect the premises and equipment and if, at any time, I feel anything to be unsafe, I will immediately leave and refuse to participate further in the event.
2. I understand the **ACTIVITIES OF THE EVENT ARE VERY DANGEROUS and INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF MY BEING SERIOUSLY INJURED OR HURT, MY BEING PARALYZED OR KILLED.**
3. 5. IN CONSIDERATION of my minor child ("the Minor") being permitted to participate in any way in the 2016 Waitsburg Celebration Days Karen Huwe Mohney Memorial ATV/UTV Poker Ride (Karen's Ride) and the Sunset Cruise in Waitsburg, Washington on Saturday, May 21 and Friday, May 20, 2016, respectively, and/or being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (including a detailed description of the course to follow) further defined as any area which requires special authorization, credentials or permission to enter or any area to which admission by the general public is restrict or prohibited; I agree:

1. I know the nature of the event and the minor's experience and capabilities and believe the Minor to be qualified to participate in the event. I will inspect the premises, facilities and equipment to be used, or with which the Minor may come into contact. IF I OR THE MINOR BELIEVE ANYTHING IS UNSAFE, I WILL INSTRUCT THE MINOR TO IMMEDIATELY LEAVE THE RESTRICTED AREA AND REFUSE TO PARTICIPATE FURTHER IN THE EVENT.
2. I HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE Walla Walla County, its officers, employees and agents, Columbia County, its officers, employees and agents, the promoters, participants, racing associations, sanctioning organizations or any subdivision thereof, track operators, track owners, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, rescue personnel, any persons in restricted area, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the event, premises or event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, consultants and other persons or entities who give recommendations, directions, or instructions to engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises or event of each of them, their directors, officers, agents, employees, representatives, owners, members, affiliates, successors and assigns, all for the purposes herein referred to as "Releasees," FROM ALL LIABILITY TO ME, THE MINOR, my and the minor's personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin, FOR ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES ON ACCOUNT OF ANY INJURY TO ME OR THE MINOR, including, but not limited to, death or damage to property, CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" OR OTHERWISE.

5. If, despite this release, I, the Minor, or anyone on the Minor's behalf, makes a claim against any of the "Releasees" named above, I AGREE TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASEES and each of them from ANY LITIGATION EXPENSES, ATTORNEYS FEES, LOSS, LIABILITY, DAMAGE, OR COST THEY MAY INCUR DUE TO THE CLAIM MADE AGAINST ANY OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED ABOVE, WHETHER THE CLAIM IS BASED ON THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" OR OTHERWISE.

- Prior to the event, all riders and players (18 years and older) must sign a release of liability waiver with the sponsoring organization and attend a pre-event meeting. Pre-registration is required for ALL riders. These meetings allows all rider to review, read event materials and ask questions of the staff and details of the course maps.
- Each rider will comply with state helmet laws at all times.
- Each card stop will have first aid kits, two-way radios and/or cell phones, water, extra course maps, and be manned by at least two volunteers.
- Volunteer flaggers will be stationed at all junctions that are not a scheduled card stop. These patrollers will provide directional assistance and remind the general driving public to limited scope of this one-day, special event.
- A volunteer pilot rider will lead all riders to ensure road safety and pacing. Another volunteer rider will follow all riders to ensure no participants are remaining on the course.
- The course is open under a temporary special use permit for the event from 7 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. on Friday, May 20 and from 1 p.m. until 4 p.m. on Saturday, May 21, 2016. The 35 mph speed limit will be in force for the duration of the events only.

1. Karen's Ride: Saturday, May 21, 2016:

- a. The **first card stop (#1)** will take place at registration, on the east side of the Waitsburg Fairgrounds.
- b. Riders will exit the fairgrounds and turn right onto 8th Street. This street will turn into Wilson Hollow Rd. and will cross into Columbia County. Riders follow Wilson Hollow Rd. approximately 3 miles until they reach Nordheim Road where a **flagger** will be present. Turn left onto Nordheim Rd. The course is gradually inclining through cropland. Continue approximately two miles to the junction of Nordheim Rd. and Whiskey Creek Rd this is the **second card stop (#2)**. The course proceeds south down Whiskey Creek Rd. for another two miles before crossing back into Walla Walla County. The road continues down Whiskey Creek for another nine miles to the Columbia County line and re-enters Columbia County for an additional quarter mile. Volunteer trail patrollers will be stationed to provide directional assistance for riders.
- c. The **third card stop (#3)** is at the junction of Whiskey Creek and Mt. Pleasant Rd. the route continues in Columbia County for another quarter mile. The event course then follows the county line for two additional miles and slips back into Columbia County for a final 2.5 miles. Columbia County roads are accessed for just over 5.6 miles during this event. Road conditions will be closely monitored. The event reaches its highest point in elevation here. A wet, early spring may dictate wet road conditions, requiring extra caution for riders. Volunteers will utilize two-way radios and cell phones for rider safety.
- d. Riders will turn right onto Mt. Pleasant Rd. and follow the county line for approximately two miles. The **fourth card stop (#4)** is at the junction of Mt. Pleasant Rd. and Wilson Hollow (Jasper Mtn. Rd.). Volunteer trail patrollers are stationed here and at major intersections to ensure rider safety and to remind the general driving public to limited scope of this one-day, special event.

- e. Riders will continue on Mt. Pleasant Rd., which will turn into Coppei. After approximately 4 miles riders will reach the intersection of Coppei and Dent Rd. this is the **fifth card stop (#5)**. This is the southern-most point of the course. After receiving their card riders will continue straight on Coppei Rd., which becomes North Coppei Creek Rd. The course continues down the grade for approximately 10 miles.
- f. Riders will continue until they reach the intersection of North Fork Coppei Creek Rd. and McCown Rd., the **sixth card stop (#6)**. Turn right on McCown Rd, to Wilson Hollow Rd. where a **flagger** will be present. Turn left back onto Wilson Hollow Rd. and proceed back to the fairgrounds. Volunteer trail patrollers are stationed here and at major intersections to ensure rider safety and to remind the general driving public to limited scope of this one-day, special event. A first aid kit is available and communications are made with two-way radios and cell phones.
- g. The **seventh card stop (#7)** is back at the fairgrounds after three final miles on Wilson Creek Rd. At each important intersection, volunteer trail patrollers will ensure rider safety, have first aid kits available and provide direction to the fairgrounds.

2. Sunset Cruise: Friday, May 20, 2016:

Know the Rules of the Road for Karen's Ride and the Sunset Cruise 3rd Weekend in May 2016

Karen's Ride and the Sunset Cruise are THE signature events this year planned during 2016 Waitsburg Celebration Days.

BEFORE you ride, please be aware that Revised Code of Washington (RCWs) must be adhered to since vehicles and drivers will be traveling on County roads in Walla Walla and Columbia Counties.

License fees are REQUIRED for every all-wheeled vehicle in Washington State. Vehicles must be registered through the County auditor or other agent and owners must pay the following fees:

Vehicle registration for wheeled all-terrain vehicle, on-road use is \$12.00 initially, as per RCW 46.09.540 and is good for one year.

Vehicle registration for wheeled all-terrain vehicles, off-road use, is \$18.00 initially, as per RCW 46.09.510 and is also good for one year. These license fees are required in addition to any filing fees, or taxes as required by law.

The department shall issue an ORV registration, decals and tabs upon receipt of:

- (a) A properly completed application for an original ORV registration; and
- (b) Payment of all fees and taxes is due at the time of application.

Registration must be carried on the vehicle for which it was issued AT ALL TIMES during its operation in this state.

Off-road vehicle decals MUST BE AFFIXED to the off-road vehicle in a manner prescribed by the department. Any out-of-state operator of such vehicles must also comply.

Driver's licenses are REQUIRED. RCW 46.09.444 states, "(1) A person may not operate a wheeled all-terrain vehicle upon a public roadway of this state, not including non-highway roads and trails, without (a) first obtaining a valid driver's license issued to Washington residents in compliance with Chapter 46.20 RCW or (b) possessing a valid driver's license issued by the state of the person's residence if the person is a nonresident." In addition, wheeled all-terrain vehicles may not be operated side-by-side in a single lane of traffic.

Licenses may be purchased at Washington Department of Motor Vehicles, 145 Jade Street, Walla Walla, (509) 527-4358, Walla Walla County Auditor, 315 West Main Street, Walla Walla, (509) 524-2545 or the Columbia County Auditor, 341 East Main Street, Dayton, (509) 382-4541.

Walla Walla and Columbia County's have issued a temporary ordinance to limit the speed of ALL vehicles on the course roadway's from 7 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. on Friday, May 20 and from 1 pm until 4 pm on Saturday, May 21, 2016, to 35 MPH. Wheeled all-terrain vehicles MAY ONLY operate on public roadways with a speed limit of 35 mph or less.

This authorization allows the County engineer to temporarily lower the speed limit pursuant to WWCC 10.04.001. The temporary speed limit is only effective once signage is in place for the planned duration of the events ONLY.

Helmets are REQUIRED for all riders and all participants must sign liability waivers. Deputy and volunteer Sheriff's will be on course from 7 pm until 8:30 pm on Friday, May 20 and 1-4 pm on Saturday, May 21, 2016 for rider safety and compliance.
